

**WCPS Device Insurance Coverage
2020-2021**

As a 1:1 school system, Washington County Public Schools (WCPS) provides a device to all students. All students are encouraged to pay the **Device Insurance Coverage** fee for their device, and have a parent-signed user agreement for the Responsible Use Guidelines found in the student handbook.

Device Insurance Coverage costs \$15 per student (year-long). If there are financial concerns due to hardship in the household, please contact the school counseling office or school administration. Online, cash and check payment options will be made available at the start of each school year.
